



**MUNICIPAL EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 06
SERIES OF 2022**

**AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE HEALTH PROTOCOLS TO BE OBSERVED
UNDER LEVEL 2 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALLACAPAN, CAGAYAN**

WHEREAS, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 2(c) of Executive Order No. 168 (s.2014) mandates the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to prevent and/or minimize the local spread of emerging infectious diseases (EID) in the country through the establishment or reinforcement of a system in screening possible patients infected with EID, contact tracing, identification of the mode of exposure to the virus, and implementation of effective quarantine and proper isolation procedures.

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force declared the whole province of Cagayan as under Alert Level 2 effective February 16, 2022 to February 28, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HARRY D. FLORIDA, Municipal Mayor of Allacapan, Cagayan, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the implementation of the following health protocols in the municipality of Allacapan.

1. Intrazonal and interzonal movement shall be allowed, provided that cockfighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming establishments shall not be allowed to operate or be undertaken.
2. The following establishments, or activities, shall be allowed to operate, or be undertaken at a maximum of 50% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals and those below 18 years of age, even in unvaccinated, and 70% outdoor venue capacity. Provided that all on site workers/employees of these establishments, or organizers of activities are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and (Management of Infectious Diseases (MPHS) shall be strictly maintained:
 - a. Venues for meetings, incentives, conferences, and exhibitions (MICE);
 - b. Permitted venues for social events such as parties, wedding receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal of baby showers;
 - c. Visitors or tourist attractions such as parks, plazas, public gardens, scenic viewpoints or overlooks, and the like;
 - d. Recreational venues such as internet cafes, billiard halls, swimming pools, and similar venues;
 - e. In-person religious gatherings; gatherings for necrological services, wakes, inurnment, and funerals for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 and for the cremains of the COVID-19 deceased;
 - f. Dine-in services of food preparation establishments such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries, subject to DTI sector-specific protocols;
 - g. Personal care establishments such as barbershops, hair spas, hair salons, and nail spas, and those offering aesthetic/cosmetic services or procedures, make-up services, salons, spas, reflexology, and other similar procedures including home service options, subject to the sector-specific protocols of the DTI;

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- h. Fitness studios, gyms, and venues for individual non-contact exercise and sports; Provided that patrons/clients and workers/employees wear face masks at all times and subject to DTI sector-specific protocols;
 - i. Contact sports approved by the LGU where such games shall be held;
 - j. Funfairs/peryas or kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playroom, and kiddie rides;
 - k. Gatherings in residences with individuals not belonging to the same household.
3. Agencies and instrumentalities of the government shall remain to be fully operational and shall adhere to at least 80% on-site capacity while applying work-from-home and other flexible work arrangements. Those assigned to work off-site shall be subject to alternative work arrangements in accordance with relevant rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission (CSC). Health and emergency frontline services, laboratory and testing services, border control, or other critical services shall operate at a workforce beyond the minimum as may be necessary to deliver their mandates.
4. Proper wearing of face mask is mandatory.

All issuances, orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly

This Executive Order shall take effect on February 16, 2022.
