



**MUNICIPAL EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01**  
**SERIES OF 2022**

**AN ORDER ESTABLISHING THE HEALTH PROTOCOLS TO BE OBSERVED  
UNDER LEVEL 3 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALLACAPAN, CAGAYAN**

**WHEREAS**, Section 15 Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

**WHEREAS**, Section 2 © of Executive Order No. 168 (s.2014) mandates the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to prevent and/or minimize the local spread of emerging infectious diseases (EID) in the country through the establishment or reinforcement of a system in screening possible patients infected with EID, contact tracing, identification of the mode of exposure to the virus, and implementation of effective quarantine and proper isolation procedures.

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force declared the whole province of Cagayan as under Alert Level 3 effective January 9, 2022 to January 15, 2022

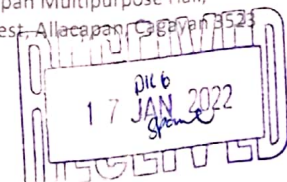
**NOW, THEREFORE, I, HARRY D. FLORIDA**, Municipal Mayor of Allacapan, Cagayan, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the implementation of the following health protocols in the municipality of Allacapan.

1. Intrazonal and interzonal movement shall be allowed, However, subject to restrictions as follows:
  - a. Those below eighteen (18) years of age, and those belonging to vulnerable population, shall be allowed access to obtain essential goods and services, or for work in permitted industries and offices in accordance with existing labor laws, rules and regulations.
  - b. Individual outdoor exercises shall be allowed for all ages regardless of comorbidities or vaccination status.
2. The following establishments and/or activities characterized as high-risk for transmission, shall not be allowed to operate, or be undertaken:
  - a. Face to face or in-person classes for basic education, except those previously approved by the MIATF;
  - b. Contact sports, except those conducted under a bubble-type setup as provided for under relevant guidelines adopted by the IATF, Games and Amusement Board, and Philippine Sports Commission and those approved by the Local Government Unit.
  - c. Funfairs/peryas and kid amusement industries such as playgrounds, playroom and kiddie rides;
  - d. Venues with live voice or wind-instrument performers and audiences such as in karaoke bars, clubs, concert halls, theaters and videokes in public places.
  - e. Cockfighting and operation of cockpits, lottery and betting shops, and other gaming activities except those authorized by the IATF or the Office of the President; and
  - f. Gatherings in residence with individuals not belonging to the same household.
3. The following establishments or activities shall be allowed to operate or be undertaken at a maximum of 30% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals only and 50% outdoor

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venue capacity. Provided that all on-site workers/employees are fully vaccinated and Management of Infectious Diseases (MPHS) shall be strictly maintained:

- a. Venues for meetings, conferences and exhibitions.
  - b. Permitted venues for social events such as parties, wedding receptions, engagement parties; wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions and bridal or baby showers;
  - c. Visitors or tourist attractions such as parks, plazas, public gardens, scenic viewpoints or overlooks and the likes;
  - d. Recreational venues such as internet cafes, billiards, amusement arcades and similar venues;
  - e. Limited face-to-face or in person classes for higher education and for technical-vocational education and training;
  - f. In-person religious gatherings; gatherings for necrological services, wakes, internment, and funerals for those who died of causes other than COVID-19 and for the remains of the COVID-19 deceased;
  - g. Dine-in services in food preparation establishments such as kiosks, restaurants and eateries, subject to DTI sector-specific protocols;
  - h. Personal care establishments such as barbershops, hair spas, salons, and spas, and those offering aesthetic/cosmetic services or procedures, make-up services, reflexology and other similar procedures including home service options, subject to the sector-specific protocols of the DTI; and
  - i. Fitness studios, gyms and venues for non-contact exercise and sport subject to DTI sector-specific protocols. Provided that patrons clients and workers/employees wear face masks at all times and that no group activities are conducted.
4. Agencies and instrumentalities of the government shall remain to be fully operational and shall adhere to at least 60% on-site work force. Those assigned to off-site shall be subject to alternative work arrangements in accordance with the relevant rules and regulations issued by the Civil Service Commission(CSC). Health and emergency frontliner services, laboratory and testing services, border control, or other critical services shall operate at a workforce beyond the minimum as may be necessary to deliver their mandates.
5. Proper wearing of masks and/or face shield is mandatory.

All issuances, orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof that are inconsistent with any provision of this order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

This Executive Order will take effect at 12:01 in the morning of January 9, 2022
